

## **Rules**

1. USGA rules govern all play, except for local exceptions below.
2. Men will play the white tees (incl. championship flight), Women will play the red tees.
3. Report all scores following each nine to our official scoring area. Please be sure to review your teams scores. Once they are posted they are permanent.
4. **NO GIMME PUTTS** - If you rake in or pick up a putt it will be scored as a DNF (did not finish). This must be strictly enforced no matter how close the ball is to the hole.
5. Any doubt on procedures or rulings, play two balls and consult the rules committee.
6. Tie, for first place only, will be decided by a sudden death playoff immediately following the completion of the flight. Playoff will begin on hole #1.
7. The roads are out of bounds on 1, 4 & 5. White stakes along rock wall on number 7 is out of bounds as well. There is no out of bounds on the back nine.  
**1 STROKE PENALTY HIT FROM PREVIOUS SPOT (no distance).**
8. Lost balls on the course you have the choice of re-hitting from previous spot or dropping a new ball in an agreed approximate spot were ball was lost. **1 STROKE PENALTY**
9. Lost Ball in the woods (front or back nine) – Two club lengths from where the ball entered woods or two club lengths from woods no closer to the hole (can go back) or previous spot. **1 STROKE PENALTY**
10. Found Balls in woods – can play as it lies or see above rule for lost balls in the woods.
11. You may help read your partner's putts and putt out of turn.
12. You have the choice of a drop zone (holes 5, 6, & 15) or point of entry "line of sight" on water hazards.
13. Free drop from cart paths, rope lines, flower boxes and other manmade course markers. One club length from closest point avoiding obstruction no closer to the hole.

**Calcutta Rules:** Teams that do not get purchased can be purchased by the team members at check in on Saturday for the average of the purchase price of the teams in that flight.

The participating teams have the option of purchasing half of the stakes in their team from the high bidder. Pay them directly or leave it at the pro shop for them prior to your round on Saturday. Any Calcutta prize money will be paid to high bidder, settle with them.

If you do not hold any stake in your team, there is **no prize money** from the Calcutta if you were to place. House owns any unclaimed teams.
